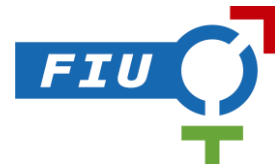

Background info for the teacher/trainer of the online course:

Crossing the line?

The aim of the course

The aim of this course is to show the participants why sexual harassment does not have a “quick fix” solution, and how to start preventing sexual harassment by playing the game “Crossing the line?”. The course will both give the participants a deeper understanding of the complexities of sexual harassment, but the aim is also to give them the tools to facilitate preventative activities, such as playing the game “Crossing the line?”, e.g. in their own workplace.

About the PowerPoint:

The entire course is contained in the PowerPoint which consists of 16 slides. The first six slides are intro slides, where the participants will get some fundamental knowledge that will be beneficial to them when they begin to play the game “Crossing the line?” which they will do from slide 10 and onwards.

The most important part of this course is that the teacher facilitates a good, open conversation between the participants when playing the game. All of the participants’ learning is depended on them playing the game, thinking about what to say, listening to each other, discussing their different points of views, and so on. The aim is *not* to make the participants come to agreements, but to become more respectful and understanding of each other’s boundaries.

Everything that is thought relevant for the teacher to say about each slide is written out in the note below each slide. The text in the notes that are in parenthesis () is meant as a note to the teacher.
