

CROSSING THE LINE

- A KICKSTARTER-KIT

Crossing the Line is a campaign which focuses on sexual harassment in the workplace. Read more about the campaign on:

Use this kickstarter kit to put sexual harassment on the agenda and to allow for a discussion about when a line has been crossed.

THE KICKSTARTER KIT CAN BE USED:

- by elected representatives to kickstart a discussion about sexual harassment among colleagues
- in the union's local departments as a kickstart to work with the Crossing the Line campaign
- in the management team in the workplace to initiate reflection on sexual harassment
- in seminars, conferences and congresses where sexual harassment can be talked about

PREPARATION:

Draw a line - it can be with a pen on the whiteboard or a coloured piece of tape on the table or floor. There just needs to be room to lay out or hang cards up on both sides of the line. Remember Blu Tack if the cards need to be hung up. Spread out all the cards on the table or on the floor - away from the line.

KICKSTART:

Present the issue:

Sexual harassment in the workplace is a serious problem. Verbal and physical abuse can make daily working life difficult for many people, especially for women. But when is something considered sexual harassment? When does a cheeky comment cross the line and become an uncomfortable and unpleasant experience for the person on the receiving end?

Ask the participants to position the cards so that the statements that they think have crossed the line are placed to the right of the line and the statements which are ok to say to a colleague are placed to the left. The more acceptable a statement is perceived, the further to the right it should be placed. The participants are allowed to talk to each other while doing this. Continue until all the cards have been positioned.

Talk about the cards' positions. Does everyone agree? Why is such and such a card placed across the line? Have any of the participants first-handedly experienced similar comments? Have you made similar comments towards a colleague (albeit with the best of intentions)?

How do you draw the line?

YOU CAN ALSO CHOOSE TO USE ONE OF THESE "OBSTRUCTIONS":

Man/woman:

You can try to do the exercise firstly with the male participants and after that with only the female participants from the same workplace/department. Document with photos and compare the outcome in a plenary session.

Older man to young woman:

Ask participants to position the cards based on the premise that the statement is said by an older male colleague to a young female colleague. Discuss what the premise means in relation to the way participants position the cards.

Young man to young woman:

Ask participants to position the cards based on the premise that the statement is said by a young, handsome male colleague to a young female colleague. Discuss what the premise means in relation to the way participants position the cards.

Again and again and again:

Ask the participants to position the cards based on the premise that it is a comment that a colleague/boss says on repeated occasion and often to the female colleague. Discuss what the premise means in relation to the way participants position the cards.
