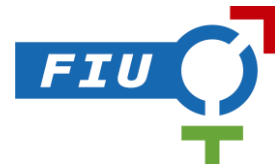




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Background info for the teacher of the online course:

LGBT+ inclusion in the workplace

The aim of the course

In this course the participants will get some fundamental knowledge about LGBT+ people and the challenges they experience in the workplace: Why this is an important topic to focus on, what LGBT+ stands for, which myths act as barriers to LGBT+ inclusion, what the connection is between LGBT+ and sexual harassment, and some facts about the challenges LGBT+ people experience in the workplace. This knowledge is very important to any workplace that wants to work actively towards a more diverse and LGBT+ inclusive workplace.

Furthermore, the participants will also get some concrete tools they can bring back to their workplace – tools that will help them the necessary steps towards creating a more diverse and LGBT+ inclusive workplace.

About the PowerPoint:

The entire course is contained in the PowerPoint which consists of 11 slides.

Everything that is thought relevant for the teacher to say about each slide is written out in the note below each slide.

In the end the participants will get a seven-question quiz. The aim of this quiz is to see how much of what the participants have learned on the course have stuck when them, to engage the participants, and to reiterate some of the most important take aways.
